GENERAL COMPETITION RULES:

- Conditions of entry**
All sections will be judged as a total look (top to toe). Your model must be able to stand and sit for judging. Judges would like to see the latest in hair & fashion. Your inspiration should come from high fashion magazines, Latest movie and music video fashion
 - Junior/Learner of the year**
The winner will be the person with the highest accumulation of points for 1st, 2nd, 3rd or runner up in designated sections. To be eligible for Junior of the year, competitors must enter the following competitions: Junior Men's Cutting, Junior Ladies Cutting.
 - Senior of the year**
The winner will be the person with the highest accumulation of points for 1st, 2nd, 3rd or runner up in designated sections. To be eligible for Senior of the year, competitors must enter the following competitions: Senior Ladies Cutting, Senior Men's Cutting.
 - In all pre-done sections**, multiple entries will be allowed. Maximum of 3 models
 - In all pre-done sections it is understood that all work presented was carried out by the competitor named on the entry form. Entry may be disqualified or award forfeited if not.
 - EOHCB** reserves the right to remove any competitor from the floor who indulges in unsafe workplace or safety practices.
 - In the event that a competitor or model sustains a wound during a competition, the competitor and their model must leave the floor until bleeding has been treated and wound securely covered.
 - No late arrival models will be included in the judging once point judging has commenced.
 - First second and third place trophies will be awarded in all sections where numbers allow
 - A minimum of 2cm needs to be cut all round (from ear to ear and front to back) on **ALL CUTTING SECTIONS**.
- PLEASE NOTE: If you intend to use your model in more than one competition, or you yourself are a model in another competition, please allow sufficient time for judging of same, as competitions will not be delayed if you or your model is not in attendance at starting time.**
- EOHCB shall not be responsible or liable for models or for any damage arising out of work performed on models hair.
 - All competitors must stop work immediately and stand away from the model when the call to do so is given. Any further contact could result in a penalty.
 - Any competitor receiving coaching during the competition may be asked to leave the floor.
 - No mobile phones will be allowed on the competition floor.
 - All models to be seated upright and forward for judging, or otherwise as directed by the chairperson of judges. All models must be able to sit, stand and parade without assistance and should not hinder any other person on the judging floor.
 - Models must not touch their own hair whilst on the competition floor.
 - Any person disturbing competitors on the floor will be removed from the venue.
 - The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
 - On completion of judging, all competitors must allow their models to be photographed by the official EOHCB photographer.
 - Any competitor who causes damage to the competition venue will be liable for costs.
 - No competitor or model shall in any competition, display, parade or performance allow his or her genitalia to be exposed or visible to any person at any time.
 - Refunds on entry fees if competition is cancelled.
 - The promoter hereby grants permission to persons only using reproduction for private or educational purposes PROVIDED the reproduction is not sold in any way.
 - The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any person(s).
 - You must state the fact your award was awarded in an EOHCB competition with the year and category of the award stated if you market by any media or advertising the winner of any Salon, College, Senior or Junior Award.
 - OMC Rules DO NOT apply anymore.**

- 1. Snr Ladies cut and style**
- 35 minutes (10am – 11am including judging). R120.00

- Jnr Ladies cut and style**
- 40 minutes (10am – 11am including judging) R70.00

Both sections will run at the same time

- The competitors are to cut and style a fashionable hairstyle that should look like it came from the cover of a fashion magazine.
- Artistic and fantasy styles are forbidden.
- Special attention will be given to the execution of colour.
- Hair must be wet and combed flat back before they are taken to the floor.
- All styling products are forbidden before the test.
- Before cutting the hair must be a minimum of 8cm all over the head.
- The hair must not be pre-cut.
- The Complete cut must be done in the allocated time.
- All products are allowed.
- A harmonious graduation of two or more colours is compulsory.
- No spray colours, extensions or ornaments allowed.

- 2. Snr Gents cut and style**
- 30 minutes (11am – 11:50am including judging). R120.00

- Jnr Gents cut and style**
- 35 minutes (11am – 11:50am including judging). R70.00

Both Sections will run at the same time

Both Sections Sponsored by Paul James Hairdressing

- Competitors create a short fashionable hairstyle.
- The finished style must be like those seen in fashion magazines.
- It must be a true fashion style appreciated by the consumer and have a masculine look.
- Special attention will be given to the execution of colour.
- Hair of the models must be wet and combed flat back before they enter the competition floor.
- Hair length at the top must be a minimum of 7cm.
- The sides and back must be a minimum of 5cm before the competition starts.
- All cutting tools are allowed. At the finish the hair length at the perimeter must not be longer than 2cm.
- A harmonious graduation of 2 or more colour shades is compulsory. Spray colours are forbidden.
- Finger styling and all styling tools are allowed.
- All fixing products are allowed. Clothing must be current fashion.
- Military uniforms or historic clothes are forbidden.
- Competitors create a short fashionable hairstyle.
- The finished style must be like those seen in fashion magazines.
- It must be a true fashion style appreciated by the consumer and have a masculine look.
- Special attention will be given to the execution of colour.
- Hair of the models must be wet and combed flat back before they enter the competition floor.
- Hair length at the top must be a minimum of 7cm.
- The sides and back must be a minimum of 5cm before the competition starts.
- All cutting tools are allowed. At the finish the hair length at the perimeter must not be longer than 2cm.
- A harmonious graduation of 2 or more colour shades is compulsory.
- Spray colours are forbidden.
- All fixing products are allowed.
- Clothing must be current fashion.
- Military uniforms or historic clothes are forbidden.

- 3. 1ST YEAR Jnr Blow dry**
- 45 minutes (11:50am – 13pm including judging). R70.00

Sponsored by Wahl

- Competitors perform a Fashionable Consumer Day Style by blow drying.
- No cutting allowed on the floor.
- Hair must be wet and combed straight and flat back before they are taken onto the floor.
- Competitors who do not observe the instructions will be penalised according to a penalty chart.
- All styling products are forbidden before the test starts.
- All products & styling tools are allowed during the test.
- The choice of colour is free.
- Make-up & accessories must be current and wearable.

- 4. WAHL CLIPPERS – LADIES FASHION CUT**
- (35 Minutes) 13:00 to 13:50 - R120.00

OPEN SECTION – ANYONE MAY ENTER (AFRO AND CAUCASIAN)

FREE HAND CLIPPER CUT ON FEMALE MODEL – ONLY WAHL CLIPPERS MAY BE USED

- The competitor carries out a trend hairstyle. At the finish the hairstyle should be like the cover of a fashion trade publication. The jury will give special attention to the execution of the colour.
- The model's hair may be wet or dry. All styling products are forbidden before the test starts. The wise men will check if this rule has been observed and will penalise in case of infringements.
- Colour. The choice of colour is free. Spray colours are forbidden.
- Tools. The competitor must use Wahl Clippers. All other cutting tools (i.e. scissors or razors) are forbidden. Cutting combs, guards and blades are allowed.
- Products. All products are allowed.
- Hair Extensions. Hair extensions are permitted.

- 5. Open Bridal**
- 45 minutes (14:00 – 15:00 including judging). R70.00

- Models proceed to the Competition floor with open Straight hair.
- The hair must not be pre-styled. - The hair can be wet or dry.
- The Competitor creates a current Bridal Hairstyle on Long Hair with a Total Look in mind.
- The Competitors may use Scissors to clean up the ends. - The hair must be shoulder length or longer.
- COLOUR IS FREE -A harmonious graduation of two (2) or more colours is compulsory.
- Spray colours are forbidden. - Hair Extensions: Up to 20% of Separate Hair Extensions can be used.
- This must be done in advance. All products are allowed. - The use of any kind of support is forbidden.
- All styling tools are allowed, including flat & curling irons.
- Ornaments must be proportional to the hairstyle and must not cover more than 30% & of the entire head. Ornaments are allowed.

- 6. WAHL CLIPPER FASHION CUT GENTS – AFRO OR CAUCASIAN**
30 minutes (15:10pm – 15:50 including judging). R120.00.

ONLY WAHL CLIPPERS TO BE USED

Open section – Street Style – Gents Fashion

ANYONE MAY ENTER (Afro & Caucasian)

- The competitor carries out a trendy hairstyle on an Afro or Caucasian model.
- At the finish the hairstyle should look like the cover of a fashion trade publication.
- The models hair may be wet or dry.
- Colour: The choice of colour is free. Spray colours are forbidden.
- Tools: The competitor must use Wahl Clippers. All other cutting tools (i.e. scissors or razors) are forbidden. Cutting combs and guards are allowed.
- Products: All products are allowed.
- Hair Extensions: Hair extensions are permitted.

- 7. Avante Garde**
- 45 minutes (16:00 – 17:00 including judging). R120.00

- Competitors will create an avant-garde style with new ideas that are innovative, experimental and forward thinking. The TOTAL look will be judged.
- Open and free section (Freedom of expression)
- This calls for more forward thinking shapes and methods with bold, highly pigmented or neon colours.
- Models proceed to the competition floor with open straight or wavy hair.
- The hair must not be pre-styled.
- The hair can be wet or dry.
- The wise men will check the hair is brushed flat back.
- Competitors may use scissors to clean up the ends but this is not a cutting section.
- All Hair pieces and products are allowed. Colour choice is free.
- Models clothes must fit Avant-garde but no indecent attire is allowed.

- 1. EOHCB CUP 2017**
10:15 – 14:15 R150.00 per team

- ANYONE MAY ENTER – THEME: STEAMED PUNK
- The team may represent a college/provider, salon or may be a combined team.
- A team may consist of: Nail Technician, Hairdresser, Make-up Artist/Therapist
- NOT MORE THAN 4 TEAM MEMBERS
- A Male and A Female model must be used. (2 Models per entry)
- Models needs to be completely natural when entering the competition floor, except for permanent hair colour must be pre-done. Hair needs to be wet and combed back. NO foundation on body or face and NO pre-done nails allowed.
- The compulsory theme needs to be clearly recognisable in all the models presented
- The competitors will create a top to toe look including Hair, Nails, Make-up and clothing etc.
- The competitors are encouraged to incorporate body painting to the total look. Not more than 20% (not compulsory)
- The judges will be judging the BEST EXTREME TOTAL LOOK with the strongest THEME (Steamed Punk) that pulls through on all aspects on the day!
- Hair length of models is not prescribed.
- All styling tools and products are allowed.
- The choice of colour is free. Spray colours are permitted.
- Ornamentation and accessories are permitted and encouraged.
- The wise men will check if the rules above has been observed and will penalise in case of infringements.
- All General competition rules apply.
- NB: A Total Look will be judged, which includes the presentation of models ("posing") of models on the day.
- ENTRIES NEEDS TO BE DONE BY NO LATER THAN 31 AUGUST 2017, NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED. LIMITED SPACE AVAILABLE

- 2. WAX ON HAIR OFF**
10:15 – 11:00 R50.00

SPONSORED BY DEPILEVE

- Competitors bring own equipment & products.
- Competitors will only be allowed Cold (strip) wax with spatula application.
- A male or female model is allowed.
- Contra indications for waxing is NOT allowed.
- Evidence (consultation card) is expected.
- It is expected of the competitor to wax only 1 (one) forearm.
- Hair length should be at least 0,5 – 1cm.
- Only one arm will be judged.
- Special attention will be given to the execution of the technique.
- Appropriate aftercare application and recommendations.
- After judging is completed, and the judges has left the floor, the competitor will be afforded an additional 15 minutes to wax the other arm of his/her model.
- All other general rules apply.

- 3. Afro Ladies cut and style - 35 min**
11:00 – 12:00 includes judging. R70.00
SPONSORED BY SOF N FREE

- Competitors carry out a fashionable day and young hairstyle with trendy colours.
- At the finish, the hairstyle should look like it could be on the front cover of a fashion magazine.
- A minimum of 3cm needs be cut from the models hair on the competition floor.
- Hair must be naturally super curly (Afro) however, prior to the competition the hair can be relaxed or straightened.
- Competitors need to adhere to the rules, penalties will be enforced
- The hair of the model can be wet or dry at the start.
- All products and styling tools are allowed.
- Make-up and accessories must be wearable and fashionable.
- The choice of hair colour is free, but minimum of 2 colours MUST BE clearly visible in the hair
- Spray colours are forbidden

- 4. Dreadlocks and Braiding (Caucasian & Afro)**
(12:00 – 13:15 Includes judging) 45minutes R70.00

SPONSORED BY STYLIN' DREDZ

- Models proceed to the Competition floor with open Straight dreadlocked or plaited hair.
- The hair must not be pre-styled. - The hair can be dry.
- The Competitor creates a current Dread or Single Hairstyle on Long Hair with a Total Look in mind.
- The Competitors may use Scissors to clean up the ends. - The hair must be shoulder length or longer.
- COLOUR IS FREE -A harmonious graduation of two (2) or more colours is compulsory. This must be done in advance.
- Spray colours are forbidden.
- All products are allowed. - The use of any kind of support is forbidden.
- Ornaments must be proportional to the hairstyle and must not cover more than 30% & of the entire head. Ornaments are allowed.

- 5. WAHL CLIPPERS SILVER BLADES AWARD**
– AFRO GENTS CLASSIC FADE - Open to All

13:15 - 14:15 30 minutes R120.00

- The competitor carries out a classic fade hairstyle on ethnic model.
- At the finish the hair line should fade from a 0' to longer on top.
- Special attention will be given to cutting the perimeter.
- Hair may be wet or dry.
- No colour is allowed
- The competitor must use Wahl Clippers, cutting combs and guards are allowed
- A razor can be used to outline the perimeter

All other cutting tools are forbidden.
